

How to *sort waste!*



- Plastic packaging, e.g. cottage cheese container, ketchup bottle
- Biscuit packaging, candy and ice cream plastic wrappers
- Soft plastic packaging e.g. plastic bags, bread bags
- Plastic bottle caps
- Styrofoam in small quantities



- Wooden cutlery, ice cream sticks
- Paper towels and napkins
- Envelopes and sticky notes
- Plants and potting soil
- Foam rubber
- Soft plastic that is not packaging, e.g. plastic binders



- Milk and yogurt paper packaging (sort the lid as plastic)
- Egg cartons
- Disposable paper cups
- Paper bags
- Wrapping paper



- Printer paper
- Newspapers
- Advertising (without plastic windows and stickers, but not sticky notes)



- Food scraps
- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Meat and fish scraps
- Leftover bread
- Tea bags
- Coffee filter with grounds
- In cases of very wet waste, place some newspaper or used paper towel at the bottom.



- Tin cans
- Foil packaging
- Aluminum foil
- Metal tubes, e.g. caviar (empty and with the cap on)
- Metal lids
- Bottle lids



- Non-depositable jars and bottles made of clear glass



- Ceramics, e.g. flower pots
- Porcelain, e.g. plates, cups
- Glass (not packaging), e.g. drinking glass, mirror glass
- Recycled in designated bins or the major recycling stations
- Before sorting – first think about whether whole items can be reused in another location.



- Non-depositable jars and bottles made of coloured glass



- Batteries are hazardous waste and should be placed in designated containers or in the major recycling stations.
- NOTE! Lithium-ion batteries must not be placed in the recycling bin for batteries. Lithium-ion batteries and end-of-life electronics should, as a first choice, be turned in to the IT Service Desk. You can also email campusservice@hb.se for help with the collection of this kind of waste.



- Aluminum cans, PET bottles, glass, and plastic bottles that can be deposited
- Should be recycled in designated bins or at major recycling centres. These can also be given to the cleaning staff.
