Name – enter name

Home address – enter complete address details

Swedish Personal Identity Number – enter Swedish organisation/corporate identity/personal identity (ID) number (see Tax/SINK [special income tax for foreign residents] decision)

Tax Identification Number (TIN) – enter TIN number

Country of issued TIN – enter the country in which TIN are issued

Citizenship – enter the citizenship of the applicant

Department/contact – enter department and contact

Bank – enter name of bank

Bank address – enter complete address of bank

Account number – to be entered if there is no IBAN

Swift/BIC – must always be entered with at least 8 positions (swift and BIC are the same thing) as: 4 letters for the bank (pos. 1-4), country code (pos. 5-6), letter/digit (pos. 7-8) for example ABBYGB2L

Sort code – 6 digits that are to be entered upon payment to England if the account number is used

BSB code – 6 digits that are to be entered in the case of accounts in Australia

CC code – 9 digits that are to be entered in the case of accounts in Canada

ABA/FW/Routing – 9 digits that are to be entered in the case of accounts in the USA (ABA/FW/Routing are the same thing).

IBAN-number – to be entered for countries that use IBAN. If the payment is to "Euro-countries" IBAN is required.

Description and date of the assignment – enter information concerning assignment

Date and signature – signatures of both guest and head/corresponding.
